Note: Police agencies are now reporting criminal incident data through NIBRS (National Incident Based Reporting System). NIBRS is a more accurate accounting of criminal incident data in that it includes all offenses included in cases as opposed to just the most serious offense as was the reporting practice in the past. As a result, you could witness a small increase (0-2%) when comparing recent criminal incident data to past data. The more accurate NIBRS tally better represents the work our teams do, the investigative costs we incur, the impact on crime victims and the demand on victim resources in our community.
