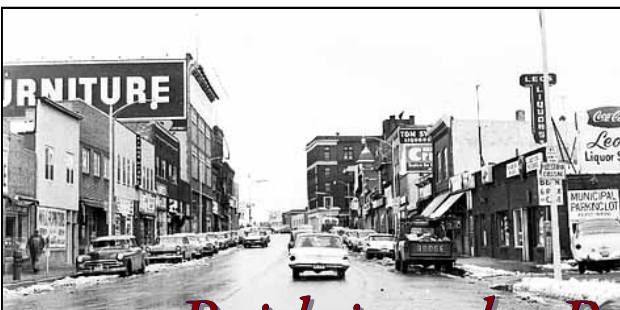
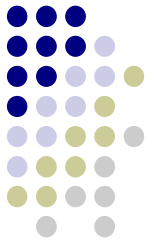
SSP/2030—*Our vision for the future*

South St. Paul's vision through the year 2030 ...

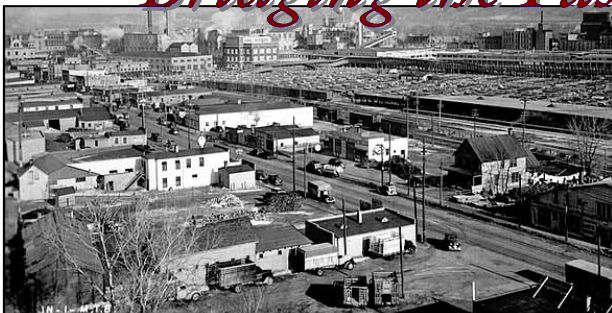
